Reference:- AKA (Qld) NKC Delegate position.

To the AKA Executive,

We wish to advise that following the AKA Qld State Karting Council Meeting held over the weekend of 16 -17 May 2009 that a vote was conducted, resulting in favour of standing down Mr. Mark Hogan as the AKAQ Delegate to the NKC.

This action was due largely to issues relating to an “In Camera” meeting that made a decision regarding an investment that every club in Queensland believed was not in the best interest of the key stakeholders of the AKA, being the karters. Furthermore, we believe that holding such matters during “In Camera” meetings does nothing other than compromise the honesty and the integrity of the delegates in the eyes of the very people they are charged to represent. These delegates should never be placed in this position.

Furthermore, we will be requesting our fellow member states to take similar actions to remove their NKC delegates that took part in this unanimous vote that has put AKA funds at undue risk, and set a very alarming precedent, along with investigating ways to prevent this transaction from being completed.

We also instruct AKA National Office and the member states and delegates not to have any further correspondence with Mark Hogan relating to AKA Qld business, and that all NKC correspondence must be forwarded directly to the State Secretary.

The AKA (Qld) Executive will advise who our temporary NKC Delegate is in due course.

AKA (Qld) Executive is also requesting that this correspondence be sent to all State Secretaries, and NKC Delegates.
