It is taken on notice that the CAMS proposal and formation of Karting Australia Limited is a wake up call that all Members of the AKA have displayed preference our States issues and should be more focused on a National basis to build a better and stronger combined Australian Karting Association.

The VKA council meeting felt that the AKA was best to serve karting, the VKA would ensure in tandem with the members of the AKA that the National governance programme is progressed correctly and urgently to best suit the needs of our sport and the National Association.
